Professor Fugee Tsung, Head of Industrial Engineering and Logistics Management at Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, and a member of our Executive Committee, was elected a Fellow of American Society for Quality (ASQ) in recognition of his significant contributions to quality. ASQ is our World Partner and it is the world's largest quality organization with more than 100,000 individual members and 1,100 corporate supporters. Prof. Tsung's citation reads as follows:

For truly outstanding academic achievements in the field of quality; for professional activities spanning many years and without national boundaries; and for personal initiatives in promoting educational programs and application projects throughout Asia.

An ASQ Fellow is an individual who has an established record of contributions to the quality profession. There are about 600 ASQ Fellows around the world. Prof. Tsung is one of few scholars from the Greater China Region to have earned such a prestigious honor. The appointment represents an international recognition of achievements of HKSQ members.

Prof. Tsung is also one of the five Fellows of the Institute of Industrial Engineers in the Greater China Region.
