Seminar on "Implementation of ISO 9001 and ISO 27001 for R&D Companies – ASTRI Experience Sharing"

Introduction	R&D companies tend to be flexible and project-based operations, making them difficult to implement ISO 9001 and ISO 27001 standards. A major challenge of such initiatives to R&D companies (including tech-startups) is to strike a balance between standardization and flexibility.
	ASTRI has been certified to ISO 9001 since 2013 and it was subsequently upgraded to ISO 9001:2015 in 2017. The certification scope is "Provision of research, development and commercialization in the area of information and communications technologies. ASTRI has also been certified to ISO 27001 since 2015. The certification scope is "The information Security Management System applied to the Research, Development and Commercialization of Financial Technologies, assessed in accordance with relevant requirements in ISO/IEC 27001:2013 and Statement of Applicability v2.0".
